Albertville Board of Education agrees to line of credit

ALBERTVILLE — The Albertville City Board of Education approved a \$1 million line of credit Tuesday as a precautionary measure.

The line of credit will be used only if monthly state funds are late in being disbursed, Superintendent Ric Ayer said.

The board accepted the Textbook Committee's recommendation to adopt the entire list of the 2009-2010 state-adopted textbooks for career and technical education, health education, physical education and technology education.

An out-of-state trip Feb. 27 for the Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps for drill competition in Chattanooga, Tenn., was approved.

Approved as surplus were two milk boxes, a dishwasher and one Hobart Mixer with attachments.

The 2010-2011 academic calendar was approved beginning with a teacher work day Aug. 5. The first day for students is Aug. 11, with the last day May 27, 2011.

The change to Bank A of the seating in the new gymnasium to have the center section with all chair-back seats with arms was approved for \$21,119.
